Dear Mr. Heitmann:

Enclosed is a Notification of Discharge of Livestock Waste that we are filing on behalf of our Wolbach Foods site.

We are of the belief that this discharge was caused by an unauthorized person who trespassed onto the Wolbach Foods property and opened a valve to the LWCF's recharge line. The valve on our recharge line has not been used by us in over two years. We have filed a report of trespassing and vandalism with the Greeley County Sheriff's Department. The report is Case No. 101009H1.

While we acknowledge that the conditions of our Operating Permit require us to file a Notification of Discharge of Livestock Waste in the event a discharge occurs, we ask that the Department take into its consideration the circumstances surrounding this discharge. The Wolbach Foods site has fallen victim to this disturbing vandalism event and we plan to take every step available to pursue prosecution of the individual(s) who caused damage to our site.
