



To sign up for a test, fill out our online form. If you live in the Omaha Lead Superfund Site or in the surrounding areas — like neighborhoods **east of 72nd Street; Bellevue, Nebraska; Carter Lake, Iowa; and Council Bluffs, Iowa** — a member of our team may come and collect a soil sample from your yard. Once tested, we will notify you of your test results unless you opt out of being informed.
